## Who is Jesus?

To begin to understand where Christianity comes from.

Why is Jesus important to Christians?

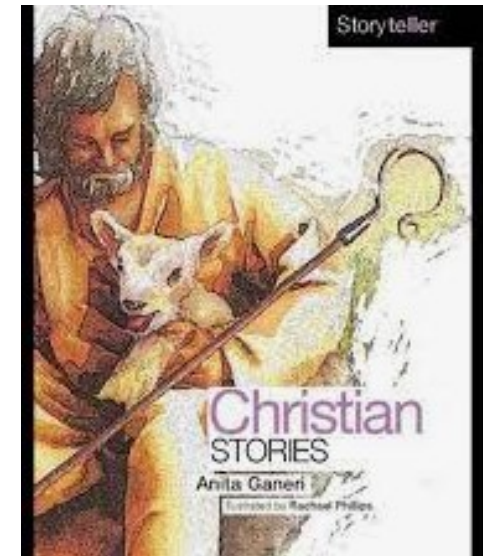
In this unit, the children will:

Know that Jesus was a historical person a 1st century Jew. Know that he is important to Christians who try to follow his teaching and example. Know that stories about him can be found in the Bible.

Know the stories about Jesus connected with Christmas and Easter and the importance of these for Christians.

To find out how Christians celebrate the festival of Easter.

Know some stories about Jesus and some stories he told. (e.g. baptism of Jesus, children brought to Jesus, calling the disciples, feeding 5000, lost sheep, lost son, Good Samaritan)



### Key vocabulary/Tier 3

Disciples	A personal follower of Jesus Christ during his life.
Crucified	Being put to death by being either nailed or bound to a cross.
Celebration	The act of celebrating an important day or event.
Resurrection	Christians believe this is the rising of Christ from the dead.
